DAUSA Capabilities with our trained leaders

- Chainsaw Teams – Clearing trees and debris to open access.
- Distribution Center support
- Cooking support
- Muck & Gut Crews – Cleaning and removing debris from flooded or damaged homes.
- Damage Assessments & Community Support – Rapid evaluation and aid coordination.
- Volunteer Training & Community Preparedness – Empowering locals to lead response efforts.
- Limited access to Heavy Equipment Operations – Skid steers, excavators, and debris removal machinery.
